The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. (However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.) If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

**"Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent."**

### PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

#### A. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF: .....\$1,695.00

This is the basic charge to each family for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this cost is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of death certificates and other necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, assistance with insurance papers, planning the funeral or memorial service, and placement of obituary notices. There will be a charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required.

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains. Also includes a fee for environmental compliance.

#### B. EMBALMING: .....\$725.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

##### • Minimum preparation and sanitary care: .....\$200.00

To include refrigeration for up to 48 hours; basic handling of remains, and placement in container or casket.

This charge does not apply when the remains are embalmed. It is our policy to immediately refrigerate all un-embalmed remains.

**Ground Transportation out of the local area is computed on a "by the mile" basis. Air Transportation charges for shipment of remains are determined by the Common Carrier.**

**F. DIRECT CREMATION: .....\$2471.34 - \$2405.00**

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes:

- Basic services of staff (including preparation/certification of death certificate)
- Initial transfer of the deceased from place of death
- Minimum Care to include Refrigeration
- Transportation to/from crematory
- Cremation Container and 8.75% California State Sales Tax
- Cremation

**ADDITIONAL: California State Filing Fee; Certified Copies of the Death Certificate**

In addition to the above, the crematory and Mortuary will make a charge for expediting the cremation (rush charge)

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers that we provide are constructed of cardboard and composition materials.

- Transfer to cemetery - scheduled by the mortuary, no services
- Supervision of the burial
- Casketing of the deceased
- Cloth covered wood casket (plus 8.75% sales tax)

**CASKETS AND ALTERNATIVE CONTAINERS:**

We offer many different styles and prices of caskets from which to select. Many caskets that appear similar in appearance may differ greatly in quality and construction. We offer the following to assist you in making an informed decision.

**PROTECTIVE.** These caskets are designed by the manufacturers to resist the entrance of air, water, and other outside elements, and are constructed of varying gauges of steel, copper, and bronze.

**NON-PROTECTIVE.** These caskets are not designed by the manufacturer to resist the entrance of outside elements, and may be constructed of hardwood, or wood products covered with fabric. A complete list will be provided at the Funeral Home.

This charge includes:

- Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff
- Transportation equipment and staff to the airport to receive remains
- Handling of shipping container
- Necessary preparation of remains
- Necessary handling of appropriate permits

**Not included: casket, merchandise, viewing of remains, certified copies of death certificate, obituary notices or any services of any type**

**Our policy requires accounts to be cared for in full prior to the time of services. There is an additional charge of \$450.00 if we must bill to the estate. We will accept insurance assignment, and Visa or Mastercard.**
